Mike Chinoy was CNN's Senior Asia Correspondent and served as a foreign correspondent for more than thirty years. After joining CNN at its London bureau in 1983, Chinoy served as Beijing Bureau Chief from 1987 to 1995. He was also Hong Kong Bureau Chief for five years. He is currently Senior Fellow at the U.S.-China Institute, University of Southern California.
