**Dr. Yasheng Huang** is professor of political economy and international management and holds International Program Professorship in Chinese Economy and Business at Sloan School of Management, Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He also holds a special-term professorship at School of Management, Fudan University and an honorary professorship at Hunan University. His previous appointments include faculty positions at the University of Michigan and at Harvard University. In addition to academic journal articles, Professor Huang has published *Inflation and Investment Controls in China* (1996), *FDI in China* (1998), *Selling China* (2003, Chinese edition, 2005), *Financial Reform in China* (2005, co-edited with Tony Saich and Edward Steinfeld), and *Capitalism with Chinese Characteristics* (2008, Chinese edition, 2010). *Capitalism with Chinese Characteristics* was selected by the Economist magazine as one of the best books published in 2008 and was 2008 Finalist/Honorable Mention in Economics, Professional & Scholarly Publishing Division, Association of American Publishers, Inc.
