Workshop Description

This workshop is listed as [Class Management and Motivation in the Chinese Classroom](#) at the website of Georgia Department of Education.

This ten-hour workshop aims at helping the Chinese teachers of high schools, middle schools, and elementary schools in the Atlanta area enhance their teaching. The workshop comprises three parts: pre-workshop (3 hours online), workshop (6 hours), and post workshop (1 hour online).

For the **pre-workshop component**, participants log into the course via WebCT/VISTA in order to access their reading assignments and to submit a short paper (about 750 words) in English presenting three successful examples from their teaching experiences. The submission deadline is **April 13th**.

The face-to-face part of the workshop is a six-hour meeting that contains two parts. The morning session (9:00 to 12:00) features the guest speaker Jian Gao, a nationally acclaimed teacher from Belmont Hill School in MA, who will demonstrate techniques and hands-on activities proven to be successful through students' performance. The afternoon session begins with a one-hour lecture given by Prof. Mariana Stone from the School of Education at NGCSU on classroom management. From 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm there will be a round-table discussion. Participants will be grouped according to their teaching levels to share their successful examples.

The **post-workshop** online component requires participants to submit a one-page conclusion of what they have learned and how they plan to apply it to their future teaching. The submission deadline is **April 27th**. Participants who complete the three components will receive a PLU certificate.

The participants interested in getting a PLU certificate will be given a code to access the WebCT/VSTA courseware at NGCSU after the registration.

The participants who do not apply for a PLU certificate can simply attend the workshop on April 18th. However, all participants need to register before midnight **April 8th**.
